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Finished size

Height: 4.72 inches
(12 cm) with the tail

Width: 3.14 inches
(8,5 cm) with the wings

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SHORTENINGS

- R** : Row
- sc** : Single crochet
- Inc** : Increase
- Dec** : Decrease
- Sist** : Slip stitch
- CH** : Chain
- Dc** : Double crochet
- Hdc** : Half double crochet
- Tr** : Treble
- *...*** : Repeat around the row



MATÉRIEL

Crochet size 2.5 mm and 2 mm

Cotton threads (size 3 - 3,5) : White, Light blue and pink (to adapt according to the color of your cat)

Wool needle

Stuffing

Glue or textile adhesive

0.5 mm nylon thread (other diameters are fine too)

0.8mm safety eyes depending on your cat's eye color

Pink embroidery thread

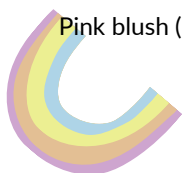
Pink blush (or eyeshadow).

Realization of the different parts

The head and the body

(to achieve with white cotton thread)

The head and the body are made in one piece to avoid sewing:

R1 : magic ring with 6 sc

R2 : 1 Inc in each sc (12)

R3 : *1 sc, 1 Inc* (18)

R4 : *2 sc, 1 Inc* (24)

R5 : *3 sc, 1 Inc* (30)

R6 : sc in each sc (30)

R7 : *4 sc, 1 Inc* (36)

R8 and R9 : sc in each sc (36)

R10 : *4 sc, 1 dec* (30)

R11 and R12 : sc in each sc (30)

Place the safety eyes 9 rows from the top and 5 sc in between.

R13 : *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)

R14 : sc in each sc (24)

Gradually stuff.

R15 : *2 sc, 1 dec* (18)

R16 : *1 sc, 1 dec* (12)



The head

We continue on the next page with the body.





R17: 1 Inc in each sc (24)

R18 and R19: sc in each sc (24)

R20: *3 sc, 1 Inc* (30)

R21: 6 sc + 2 dec + 7 sc + 2 dec +
9 sc

R22 to R28: sc in each sc (26)

R29: *3 sc, 1 dec* x5 + 1 sc

R30: *2 sc, 1 dec* x5 + 1 sc

R31: *1 sc, 1 dec* x5 + 1 sc

Finish stuffing.

R32: 5 dec + 1 sc (6)

R33: Cut your thread and pass it
through the front loop the 6 sc
then tighten and pull it in to close
the work.

Final result for the body





The ears x2

(to achieve with the cotton thread)

R1 : magic ring with 4 sc

R2 : sc in each sc (4)

R3 : 1 Inc in each sc (8)

R4 : *1 sc, 1 Inc* (12)

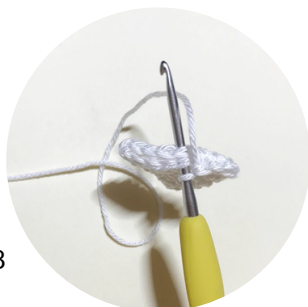
R5 : *2 sc, 1 Inc* (16)

R6 and R7 : sc in each sc (16)

R8 : Fold the ear and close it by making 8 sc, connecting the 2 edges.

Don't stuff.

Leave some thread for sewing later.



Ears closure



Final result for the ears





The paws x4

(to achieve with white cotton thread)

R1 : magic ring with 4 sc

R2 : 1 Inc in each sc (8)

R3 to R6 : sc in each sc (8)

Stuff lightly.

R7 : Fold the paw and close it by making 4 sc, connecting the 2 edges.

Leave some thread for sewing later.



Final result for the paws

The tail

(to achieve with white cotton thread)

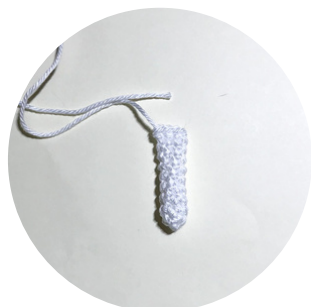
R1 : magic ring with 6 sc

R2 to R9 : sc in each sc (6)

R10 : Fold and close the tail by making 3 sc, connecting the 2 edges.

Don't stuff.

Leave some thread for sewing later.



Final result for the tail





The wings x2

(to achieve with light blue cotton thread)

R1 : magic ring with 6 sc

R2 : 1 Inc in each sc + 1 CH

R3 : Turn, 6 sc + 1 Inc + 2 sc + 1 SSt + 1 CH

R4 : Turn, 4 sc + 1 Inc + 6 sc + 3 CH

R5 : Turn, 8 sc + 1 Inc + 5 sc + 1 CH

R6 : Turn, 4 sc + 1 Inc + 10 sc + 3 CH

R7 : Turn, 11 sc + 1 Inc + 6 sc

Leave some thread for sewing later.



Final result for the wings





The heart

(to achieve with pink cotton thread and 2 mm crochet/hook)

R1: magic ring with 9 sc + 1 SISt for close the row

R2: -> in the same stitch where you made the SISt -> 2 Dc and

1 Dtr

-> 2 Dc

-> 1 Hdc

-> 1 sc

-> in the same stitch, 1 Hdc + 1 Dtr + 1 Hdc (forms the tip of the heart)

-> 1 sc

-> 1 Hdc

-> 2 Dc

-> in the same stitch, 1 Dtr + 2 Dc

-> 1 CH and 1 SISt in the 1st starting stitch of the row

Tuck in the threads at the back and cut.



Final result for the heart





Finishes of the all parts

-> Sew the ears to the head.



-> Sew the legs to the body.



-> Sew the tail to the body.



-> Sew the wings.





-> Embroider the nose with pink embroidery thread or the color of your choice.

-> Cut about 7 cm of nylon thread and pass it using your wool needle. To be done twice and put a dot of glue on each exit of the mustaches to hold them together.

-> Using a makeup brush, very lightly apply blush (or eye shadow) to the inside of the ears.

-> Stick the heart on the cat's belly.
